

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Alabama, at a Special Session which began January 3, 1956 and ended February 14, 1956, passed Act No. 96, Senate Bill 5, and same was approved by the Governor on February 9, 1956, said Act providing that the Governor may by Executive Order authorize the State Department of Revenue to provide by proper rules and regulations for the allowance of a discount not to exceed 5% of the first one hundred dollars of taxes levied and 2% of the taxes levied over one hundred dollars, payable to the State by any person subject to the lodging tax levied by Act. No. 248, approved August 16, 1955; provided, however, that no discount shall be authorized or allowed upon any lodging taxes which are not paid before delinquency as in said Act provided;

NOW THEREFORE, I, James E. Folsom, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby authorize and empower the State Department of Revenue to provide by proper rules and regulations for the allowance of such discount not to exceed 5% of the first one hundred dollars of taxes levied and 2% of the taxes levied over one hundred dollars due and payable to the State under the provisions of Act No. 248, House Bill 87, approved August 16, 1955; provided, however, that no discount shall be authorized and allowed upon any taxes which are not paid before delinquency.
