

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER FIFTY

WHEREAS, to Act, Education Amendments of 1972 (P. L. 92-318), requires the designation of one State Commission to administer various provisions of the Act for post-secondary education within the state; and

WHEREAS, the said Commission must be broadly and equitably representative of the general public, private non-profit and proprietary institutions, public post-secondary institutions, including community and junior colleges, post-secondary vocational schools, area vocational schools and technical institutes, and four-year institutions of Higher Education and branches thereof; and

WHEREAS, Sections 150, 603, and 704 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 may be encompassed within the authorization of the Commission as permitted by said legislation; and

WHEREAS, none of the existing agencies or commissions meet said criteria:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, George C. Wallace, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby create and establish the Alabama Post-Secondary 1202 Commission which shall consist of nine (9) members, appointed by the Governor and who shall serve at his pleasure. The said Commission shall consist of at least one (1) member from each of the seven (7) congressional

districts of this state and two (2) members at large. Said members shall be representative of, familiar with, and knowledgeable in private non-profit and proprietary institutions, public post-secondary institutions, including community and junior colleges, post-secondary vocational schools, area vocational schools and technical institutes, and four-year institutions of Higher Education and branches thereof, and the general public.

The State Superintendent of Education is hereby designated as the Chief Administrative Officer of said Commission except that said Commission at its first meeting shall appoint its own presiding officer and adopt such procedures as it may from time to time desire to carry forth the provisions of Public Law 92-318.
