
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no voucher will be paid unless the purchase order attached to that voucher has been previously approved by the Governor as before.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that you will proceed to assemble all state salvage in central points within the State and advertise said salvage for sale at public auction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this order be sent to the State Purchasing Agent, J. B. King, and the State Comptroller, John Graves.
