EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22

In order that the taxpayers of our State may be furnished with improved service, and at the same time effect a savings in operating expenses, the Commissioner of Revenue is hereby ordered to establish a district office of the Revenue Department in the following cities:

Huntsville, Gadsden, Hamilton, Birmingham, Tuscaloosa, Demopolis, Opelika, Montgomery, Monroeville, Mobile, Elba and Dothan.

The Commissioner is directed to staff each of these offices with thoroughly trained men who shall be directly responsible to me through the Commissioner's office and control; and that training programs shall be arranged so that field personnel may be at all times informed on tax matters arising in their respective territory or area and be capable of transacting any business of the office.

The Commissioner is further directed to effectuate an appropriate Standing Operating Procedure for use in carrying out the provisions of this order.
